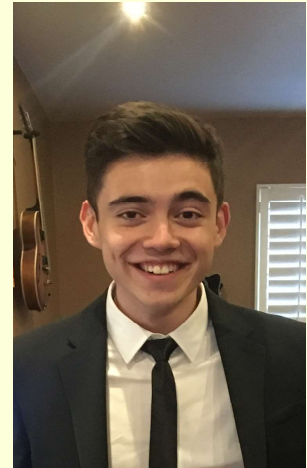
based on the efforts of the individual delegates.

Andrew Valdez

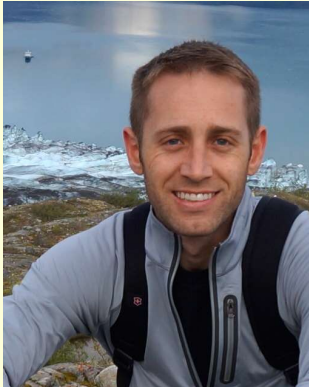


“The admissions counselor at Harvard denied me, so I became an admissions counselor”
